## From the Pastor:

I have to admit that I am a “fair weather” fan when it comes to most sports. When I was younger I could really get wrapped up in “my teams” and follow them whether they were having a winning season or not. Since I grew up in Central Illinois, I was an Illini, Bears and White Sox fan. After attending seminary in St. Louis, I became a Cardinal fan. Moving to Southern California to serve in my first church turned me into Dodger and UCLA fans. Even though we lived in Michigan for almost 24 years, I still can’t bring myself to root for the University of Michigan to beat the Illini or for the Lions to defeat the Bears. My interest in sports and my team loyalty has been diluted and faded over the years.

Does the same thing happen with our faith? There are certainly times in our lives when our faith is stronger, our relationship with Jesus Christ more personal. But do we let other things get in the way of our relationship with Jesus? Do we allow the business of life, the demands on our time to diminish our commitment to Jesus? Unfortunately it can happen. It is far too easy to drift away from the Lord and let our faith diminish in importance.

But God’s love for us never changes. God’s love for all people is unconditional. God is love. We can’t make God love us any more and we can’t do anything to make God love us any less. God proved that by sending His Son, Jesus Christ, into the world to pay the price for our sins. God is not a “fair weather” fan when it comes to you, to me and to every single person in the world.

God tells us to love our neighbors, to love our enemies, to do good for those who hate us. God wants His unconditional love to reach others through us. God loves us even when He does not approve of the things that we do. God wants us to love and care for others even when we don’t agree with the things that they do. This is so important right now when so many people think Christians are hateful or judgmental.

Jesus tells us what we should do. *“You are the light of the world—like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden. No one lights a lamp and then puts it under a basket. Instead, a lamp is placed on a stand, where it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father.”* (Matthew 5:14-16 NLT)  
Jesus doesn’t want us to be “Fair Weather” friends of the people in our lives. He wants to let His Unconditional Love reach others through us.

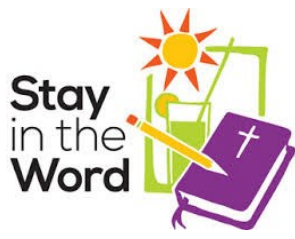

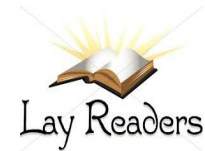
