## From the Pastor: “Meet Gen Z”

The world that we live in has changed dramatically. Generation Z, the young people born between 1999 and 2015 is the largest generation yet. These young people have been influenced and shaped by our increasingly secular culture. They are likely to have a huge influence on the future direction and views of our nation. We need to gain a greater understanding of this Generation if we want to raise our own children and grandchildren as Christians and if we want to understand our times and know how to respond.

During the Sunday Morning Adult Bible Class beginning March 3rd, I will lead this study drawing on a variety of resources including “Gen Z” by the Barna Institute, “Meet Generation Z” by James White, the Impact 360 video and online discussion resource on Gen Z and other resources. We will look at the Gen Z:

- Identity: How they define themselves, what makes them who they are
- Worldview: Their spiritual and moral beliefs and understanding of what life is about
- Motivations: Their life goals and priorities, what they think is important.
- View on Faith, Church and Christianity

The time we spend together may help us gain a better understanding of the young people in our homes, our church and our community. The direction and discussion will be guided by the information I can gather and the questions and concerns raised by those attending. We will begin the first week with an introduction and go from there. You can find out more information by going to the Impact 360 website and joining the Gen Z lab. <https://genzlab.impact360institute.org/>

This may be one of the most challenging generations for Christian parents to raise in our nation’s history. That means it may also present some very big opportunities for Christians and Christian churches. I encourage all adults to join me for this very important time of study, reflection and prayer. The Sunday Morning Adult Bible Class meets Sundays from 9:45 – 10:45 AM. The Gen Z study will begin March 3<sup>rd</sup> and conclude on April 14<sup>th</sup>.

# Lent



Soon we will enter the Season of Lent ... a six-week journey of solemn reflection on the passion, suffering and substitutionary death of Jesus Christ on the Cross. This Lenten Journey begins on Ash Wednesday, March 6, 2019 - and culminates on Easter Sunday, April 21, 2019.

Lent is the journey we make as we travel with Christ from the Mount of Transfiguration ... all the way to Jerusalem where He will face the cross and the grave for our sakes. It is a very sobering trip, a journey that often struggles to find joy. But there is Easter at the end of that journey!

This year our theme for our Midweek Lenten worship will focus upon *making a journey*, but perhaps not in the way we usually travel. Our theme will be "*Return from Exile: A Lenten Journey.*" All journeys must have a starting point; and in this Lenten season we will consider our starting point a *land of exile*.

The land of exile from which we begin our journey is the *wilderness of sin and death*. Because Adam and Eve sinned, we have inherited from them not only the sin itself, but also the result of that sin—separation from our Lord and God. From the first sin in the first garden, we have been exiled into the wilderness where we have wandered without any ability to find our way out.

This is the beginning of our journey: exile. But every journey also has a destination, an ending point. Our return from exile brings us into the Promised Land. Our relationship with our God is restored by Christ's sacrifice. Our destination is the new garden of heaven—which was established for us by Jesus' death and resurrection. There is great joy in the journey as we see where our returning brings us; but there is also a somber attitude when we consider what Christ faced in His journey on account of our sin.

All journeys consist of many events that take place between the journey's beginning and its end. Our Lenten journey is no different. Each leg of our Lenten journey begins in the Old Testament and then continues into the New Testament, pointing us to the joy that is ours in Christ Jesus. Do not be surprised to discover that from the very beginning it is Christ who travels with us. He has always been our guide, from the very beginning, and He will journey with us to the very end.

Life is full of journeys. Life itself is a journey. We enter this Lenten season contemplating the reality of our earthly journey - but with eyes fixed on its destination—the empty tomb and the open gates of everlasting life. What joy there is in knowing that we do not walk this way alone!

You are invited to join us for this Lenten Journey, *Return from Exile*, by attending all of the special Midweek Lenten Worship Services. An exciting series of Lenten Messages will be preached by Pastor Larry Courson and Pastor Michael Ruhl.

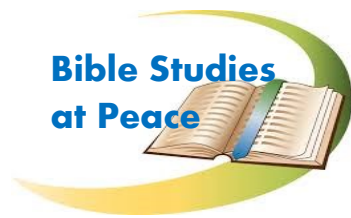
## Youth Praise Band, “God Squad”, Sundays at 7:45 PM
