From the Pastor. . . Great Expectations

The University of Michigan football season kicks off August 31st with “Great Expectations.” People expect this to be the best year for Michigan Football under Coach Harbaugh. I’ve heard some people predict that this will be the year that Michigan finally beats Ohio State, wins the Big Ten title and goes to the College Football Playoffs. We will have to wait and see if the team lives up to these expectations.

What about us? What expectations do we have for our Christian Faith and life? Jesus Christ lived up to all of the Prophecies in the Old Testament about the Promised Savior. The Apostle Paul wrote, *“But when the right time came, God sent his Son, born of a woman, subject to the law. God sent him to buy freedom for us who were slaves to the law, so that he could adopt us as his very own children.”* (Galatians 4:4-5 New Living Translation) Jesus took our place under the Law. He paid the price for our sins. He gives us the forgiveness and life we could never earn or deserve on our own.

So what does God expect from us in response? Jesus said, *“The time promised by God has come at last! The Kingdom of God is near! Repent of your sins and believe the Good News!”* (Mark 1:15 NLT) The Prophet Micah tells us, *“The Lord has told you what is good, and this is what he requires of you: to do what is right, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God.”* (Micah 6:8 NLT) When asked what the greatest commandment is, Jesus said, *“You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: Love your neighbor as yourself.”* (Matthew 22:37-38 NLT) These words talk about our relationship with God and with other people. Jesus came to restore our relationship with God and to help us with our personal relationships.

What are our expectations for members of God’s family at Peace? Here are a few that I think are worth aiming for:

Attend worship services every week. It doesn’t have to be at Peace. Worship God where ever you are on the weekend. We have the Sunday evening service for those who have other commitments on Sunday mornings.

Serve society outside of the church or through an outreach ministry of Peace. This is the way that we can show God’s love for our neighbors.

Participate regularly in Bible Study. Jesus says we need to stay connected to Him. Personal and group Bible studies are one of the best ways we can stay connected with God and with our fellow Christians.

Every good gift we have come from God. Give back a percent of your income to the church, to help us grow God’s family.

God doesn’t expect us to be perfect. He knows that we are not. But He does want us to be faithful to Him and to extend His loves to those around us.

If we all made it our personal goal with the Holy Spirit’s help to live in a way that gives praise and glory to God, we can make a difference for the good in our families, our church and our community. Wouldn’t that be great! We might even exceed the expectation people have for us.

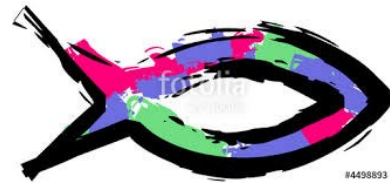
All Pro Dads and Moms

Christmas Decorations!



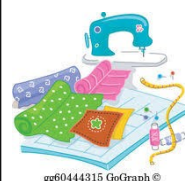
Dorothee Paulun is planning decorations for Peace for the Christmas season. There are some ideas currently being worked on.
